FIND Outdoors Now Offers Camping at Lake Russell Through Winter

Mount Airy, GA – FIND Outdoors, a 48-year-old nonprofit based in Pisgah Forest NC and operator of Lake Russell Recreation Area, is pleased to announce the extension of the camping season for Lake Russell through the winter.

The decision to extend the season was a coordinated effort by FIND Outdoors and the Chattahoochee Oconee National Forest in Mount Airy, Georgia. FIND Outdoors Chief Operating Officer Beth Hooper said of the decision, "The campground is a staple in the region and we have received feedback from the public that there is a need for more recreational opportunities during the winter months. We are grateful to the Forest Service for partnering with us to make it happen."

FIND Outdoors' mission of education and recreation on public lands dates back to the 1970's, when the Forest Service began offering small nonprofits the opportunity to bid on their campgrounds as a source of revenue. Over four decades later, FIND now operates over 20 campgrounds, visitor centers and recreation areas in three states, all of which use outdoor, experiential education as a way to tie the sites back to FIND's mission.

Beginning immediately, the following amenities will be offered for campers at Lake Russell:

- Loop B will be kept open through the winter with one heated bathhouse available.
- Same number of sites available through <u>www.recreation.gov</u>.
- Onsite FIND Outdoors Campground Managers to assist campers as needed.
- Boat launch will remain open.
- Nancytown Day Use Area will be open from 8:00 5:00pm daily.

As you're planning your camping excursion with us this season, FIND asks that you keep in mind that staff will be very limited at Lake Russell until spring. Therefor the campground day use, beach area and pavilions will remain closed to the public until the full campground opens in April.





Hooper concluded, "Winter camping is a great way to extend the season, avoid the large crowds and discover the outdoors in a whole different way. We hope you FIND your way to Lake Russell Campground this winter!"
