FIND Outdoors Launches "The Point" at Morganton Point Recreation Area

Morganton Point, GA – FIND Outdoors, a 49-year-old North Carolina nonprofit specializing in education, recreation and facility management, are set to unveil a new retail and recreation space at Morganton Point Recreation called "The Point" beginning in April, 2021.

"This is such an exciting time for FIND." explains Natalie Britt, President and CEO, "We continue to grow in ways that we hope will excite our community and provide our visitors with the exceptional services that they have come to expect."

The Point, located on a peninsula within Morganton Point Recreation Area in the north Georgia mountains, is a popular beachfront and picnic spot that holds an incredible view of Lake Blue Ridge and doubles as a boat launch and swimming area. With the addition of a retail building at The Point, FIND staff identified the need to provide beach-goers with amenities that enhance their visit and create a true sense of outdoor adventure.

Richard Coadwell, FIND's Retail Operations Director, is excited about the new addition to Morganton Point. "Whether you choose to explore the beauty of Lake Blue Ridge by kayak or just forgot your sunscreen, we hope, through our expanded operations and retail space, to further enhance our visitors' enjoyment of these public lands." The Point is set to open in mid-April.

Along with the kayak and stand-up paddle rentals that visitors have enjoyed for years, FIND has given the retail space a complete facelift to accommodate Morganton Point memorabilia, snacks, drinks and even camping supplies. "We'll have a little bit of everything that you might need or want at The Point", Coadwell explains. "The opportunities are endless."
