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FIND Outdoors Launches "Race to Restore" Initiative for Pisgah National Forest

Pisgah Forest, NC – FIND Outdoors, a 49-year-old local nonprofit with a mission of education and recreation for all on public lands, is launching the "Race to Restore" initiative to benefit the trail systems throughout the Pisgah National Forest which includes the 6,500-acre Pink Beds Valley.

Due to Tropical Storm Fred and the ongoing efforts to assess, rehabilitate and protect the trails within the Pisgah Ranger District, FIND recently made the difficult decision to cancel its biggest fundraising event – the Cradle to Grave 30K and 10K trail races. Instead, the local organization is thrilled to continue to work with the race sponsors and participants to pivot those dollars towards trail restoration in Pisgah National Forest. The fundraising campaign will be called "The Race to Restore", and will be an exciting step towards FIND's mission of stewardship of our local, public lands.

"Reassessing the Cradle to Grave Race made the most sense as we witnessed, firsthand, the flooding damage caused by the recent tropical storms," explained Tad Fogel, FIND Board Chair. "Once we made the decision to cancel, our entire focus shifted to the immediate needs of our partners and other, local nonprofits that are dedicated to the health of Pisgah National Forest."

The Race to Restore initiative will be spearheaded by FIND Outdoors, who is proud to announce that 100% of the sponsorship dollars will shift to supporting the difficult trail rehabilitation efforts in the 6,500-acre Cradle campus, which is housed within the Pink Beds Valley of Pisgah National Forest. The FIND development team was especially thrilled with the outpouring of support from "Title Sponsor" Hunter Subaru, who has been instrumental in their generosity for past Cradle to Grave races, as well as sponsorships from Ecusta Brewing Company, Morrow Insurance, Broad Street Wines, Bartlett Tree Experts, First Citizens Bank, Reese Landscaping

Lastly, FIND will develop online and social media opportunities for the public to get involved with the trail rehabilitation into 2022. Your support will provide materials, equipment and supplies to repair bridges and boardwalks within the Pink Beds, along with rerouting heavily eroded trails and clearing the debris from the same areas that are used and enjoyed by thousands of visitors each year.
